All persons traveling to the Village of Buckland are required to complete the Travel Declaration Form and take a COVID-19 Rapid Test prior to coming to our village. The City of Buckland requests that NON residential members be prohibited from flying into Buckland. Anyone traveling to Buckland has to get approval from the Mayor, Tim Gavin(907-494-5004), before proceeding on the plane.

The City of Buckland is requesting Bering Air and Ravn stop all non-residential members from coming to our community so that we can keep the virus from reaching our village until further notice.

The City Office is only taking over-the-phone payments at this time.


Residents and family members are to call Maniilaq PHN at 907-442-7144 within 24 hours of arriving in the region and also if you have any of the symptoms such as fever, coughing, or difficulty breathing.

We are asking that you respectfully follow the City of Buckland's announcement for the health and safety of our residents.

It is mandatory that everyone coming from an effected area is to self-quarantine for 14 days.

The City of Buckland prohibits anyone flying out of town unless it's an emergency.

Amendment to Travel Order No. 1

COVID-19 Rapid Testing Request Language in Village Proclamations

April 20, 2020

Maniilaq Association has been working diligently under 2 broad mandates related to COVID-19:


1. Keep COVID-19 out of the Maniilaq Service Area, and
2. Be prepared for when COVID-19 is in the Maniilaq Service Area.

Activities that support keeping COVID-19 out of the region requires a lot of communication and collaboration with many entities. In the recent weeks Maniilaq Health Center's Public Health Nursing staff have been approaching Alaska Airlines passengers when flights arrive. Passengers are asked to voluntarily fill out a Travel Declaration Form, assess symptoms, and most recently, asked if they would like a COVID-19 rapid test. This helps distribute accurate COVID-19 information, and now **can help in determining if passengers are positive for COVID-19**. This is particularly important for passengers who are traveling on to one of the villages in the Maniilaq Service Area.


Now that rapid testing is available, **Maniilaq is capable of rapid testing all people traveling to your village for COVID-19**. Rapid testing is extremely useful in detecting the presence of COVID-19 in order to prevent it from spreading. If your Tribe decides it would like to require testing of all travelers, below is sample language that could be added to your village's proclamation. As soon as Maniilaq receives a copy of the revised proclamation, we would start administering the rapid tests. Please note that during this unprecedented time, no state or federal guidance has specifically recognized Tribes' right to require testing of people traveling to their villages. We understand that given this pandemic each Tribe is making the decisions it needs to make to protect the health and welfare of their village. **This will be in effect until further notice.**

Draft language for your village COVID-19 proclamation:

"All persons traveling to the Village of Buckland are required to complete the *Travel Declaration Form* and take a *COVID-19 Rapid Test* (administered by the Maniilaq Health Center) prior to their coming to our village."


All Tribal Member or Village Residents

THE NATIVE VILLAGE OF BUCKLAND REQUIRES ALL PERSONS TRAVELING INTO THE VILLAGE OF BUCKLAND FROM OUT OF OUR REGION TO COMPLETE THE TRAVEL DECLARATION FORM AND TAKE A COVID-19 RAPID TEST (Administered by the Maniilaq Health Center) PRIOR TO COMING TO OUR VILLAGE.


THIS PROCLAMATION WAS MADE ON APRIL 21, 2020 AND HEREBY IS AMENDED ON MAY 20, 2020 TO INCLUDE THAT ALL NON RESIDENT TRAVELERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING OUR VILLAGE AND ALL TRAVELERS INTO BUCKLAND WILL BE MANDATED TO QUARANTINE FOR FOURTEEN (14) DAYS EITHER AT THE PROVIDED QUARANTINE AREA OR AT YOUR HOME.

THE NATIVE VILLAGE OF BUCKLAND ALSO SUPPORTS THE CITY OF BUCKLAND'S TRAVEL POLICIES/AMENDMENTS.

WE THE TRIBAL COUNCIL FOR THE NATIVE VILLAGE OF BUCKLAND TAKE THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC VERY SERIOUSLY AND WANT TO PROTECT OUR VILLAGE FROM THE CORONA VIRUS, WE CHERISH OUR ELDERS, CHILDREN AND ALL RESIDENTS, THANK YOU FOR FOLLOWING ALL THE MANDATES MADE BY THE GOVERNMENT, NWAB, AND OUR LOCAL TASK FORCE.
