## Fifteen Kotzebue Residents and Two Non-Residents Test Positive for COVID-19

November 9, 2020, 3:00 pm – A non-NWAB resident tested positive for COVID-19 on November 3<sup>rd</sup> in Kotzebue. The individual is not linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are mildly symptomatic and are in isolation in Kotzebue.

A Kotzebue resident tested positive for COVID-19 on November 3<sup>rd</sup> in Kotzebue. Before arriving, the individual had not been in the region for several months and are not linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are asymptomatic and in isolation in Kotzebue.

Five Kotzebue residents tested positive for COVID-19 on November 4<sup>th</sup> in Kotzebue. One individual has mild symptoms and the others are asymptomatic. They are not linked to a known COVID-19 case and are in isolation in Kotzebue.

A Kotzebue resident tested positive for COVID-19 on November 4<sup>th</sup> in Kotzebue. The individual is linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are mildly symptomatic and in isolation in Kotzebue.

Two Kotzebue residents tested positive for COVID-19 on November 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> in Kotzebue. The individuals are linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are mildly symptomatic and in isolation in Kotzebue.

Four Kotzebue residents tested positive for COVID-19 on November 6<sup>th</sup> in Kotzebue. Two individuals are mildly symptomatic and the others are asymptomatic. None of the four individuals are linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are in isolation in Kotzebue.

Two Kotzebue residents tested positive for COVID-19 on November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> in Kotzebue. The individuals are not linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are mildly symptomatic and in isolation in Kotzebue.

A non-resident tested positive for COVID-19 on November 7<sup>th</sup> in Kotzebue. The individual is not linked to a known COVID-19 case. They are mildly symptomatic and in isolation in Kotzebue.

If residents believe they have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop a fever and symptoms, such as a dry cough or difficulty breathing, call your healthcare provider for medical advice or call Maniilaq's COVID-19 Hotline at 833-442-7015. The following symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle pain or body aches

- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

**It is essential to self-quarantine until test results are received once you arrive in Kotzebue.** It can take up to a week before your COVID-19 results are available, and its important you are not actively out in the community during that time.
