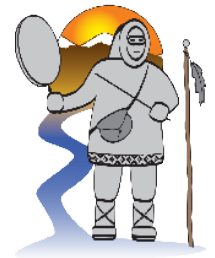


Current Vaccination Rate for the Maniilaq Service Area



Wearing masks and social distancing help reduce your chance of being exposed to the virus or spreading it to others, but these measures are not enough. Vaccines will work with your immune system so it will be ready to fight the virus if you are exposed. The combination of getting vaccinated and following CDC's recommendations to protect yourself and others will offer the best protection from COVID-19.

Maniilaq is working to get each of our communities vaccinated in a timely manner. While experts don't yet know what percentage of people would need to get vaccinated to achieve herd immunity, vaccination is a safer way to build protection than getting sick with COVID-19. We strive to vaccinate all residents willing to take the vaccine who are 16 years and older.

As of April 14th, the below tables show the percent of individuals 16 years and older that have been vaccinated.
