## NMS QUESTIONS

There are two dates listed in the RFP for submitting questions: 1.4 lists a June 6 deadline and 1.6 says 5 calendar days before the due date of proposals (June 27), so we are hoping questions are still allowed and would like to submit the following questions:

- 1. Can you please clarify proposal submission is email only and not printed copies? Pages 4 and 23 of the RFP give conflicting instructions on submittal requirements. This revised RFP is going out and correcting the two dates.
- 2. Can you please clarify what you mean in the evaluation for the second Project Approach area? Are you looking for staffing information and how bidders respond to staffing outages? Provide recent historical data that shows the number of outages and average time it took to resolve the outage issues in the last three years in services provided to a similar organization. Yes, we are looking at how the bidders would respond to staffing outages.
- 3. Do you already have property management software that you are using and can we use the same or do we need to provide our own? No, we do not have software.
- 4. Can you provide information on current staffing for this project? We currently are staffed with 2 in management roles, 6 house keepers, 1 admin assistant, 7 night watchman.
- 5. Do you expect to have security guard staffing in each village (Point Hope and Kivalina)? No, we do not expect the villages to have security guards in the housing units.
- 6. Are medevac services the responsibility of the contractor? If so, please provide historical data that we can use for pricing. We apologize and have fixed this reference.
- 7. Would you consider a cost-plus contract considering the variables associated with activities in managing this contract? We will consider a cost plus methodology as long as it is not cost plus percentage methodology and Maniilaq has the ability to approve the budgets.
- 8. We would like to request an extension on the deadline for submittal. Is it possible to extend submittal date to July 18<sup>th</sup> 2025 instead of June 27<sup>th</sup>? We will keep it at June 27, 2025
